Details: Available to all charter schools, school districts, and library systems who file Category 2 E-Rate Applications and where those applications are subsequently funded by USAC, the South Carolina E-Rate Consortium will provide state matching funds for the non-discounted share of the Category 2 E-Rate Application.

The South Carolina Category 2 E-Rate State Matching Funds Program is designed to incentivize charter schools, school districts, and library systems to participate in the Category 2 E-Rate program.

For example, a school district with a Category 2 E-Rate Discount Percentage of 85% files a Form 471 totaling \$10,000. The discounted share (federal share) would equal \$8,500 and the non-discounted share (district share) would equal \$1,500.

If this school district's E-Rate application is funded by USAC and the school district completes the work described in the application, the Consortium will reimburse the school district the non-discounted share or \$1,500.
