The eligibility criteria are listed in the accountability manual. The teacher and student surveys will be open February 26, 2024, through April 12, 2024. All students grade 3 through 12 must be offered the opportunity to participate in the survey. The survey may be read to struggling readers. The adult administering the survey should follow the oral administration guidelines: Read the survey exactly as it is written. Be aware of the grammatical make-up and structure of the items. An unconscious pause, change of inflection, and/or facial expression can be misleading or distracting to the student. Allow breaks in your voice to convey commas, end-of-sentence punctuation, and paragraph breaks. Pause between statements to give the student time to reflect on the items. Follow the student's direction as to how quickly or slowly to read. Pause at the student's request. Students may be directed to raise a hand if they need help reading words presented in the survey.
