## **RACIAL COMPOSITION**

The Charter Institute at Erskine retains responsibility for ensuring that the enrollment at each portfolio school complies with Section 59-40-50(7) of the Charter Schools Act. This requires that the enrollment 'reflects that of the local school district in which the charter school is located or that of the targeted students population of the local school district that the charter school proposed to served, to be defined as differing by no more than twenty percent from that population.'
