Details: As outlined in Section 8.7, Monthly and quarterly reporting, of the Charter Contract, the School shall be responsible for entering a monthly upload of all financial transactions in the format prescribed by the Sponsor by the 15th day of the subsequent month and a yearly upload of the audited adjustments by November 15. In addition, the School shall be responsible for submitting a quarterly financial statement in the format prescribed by the Sponsor by the 15th day of the month following the end of each quarter. The Parties agree that it is the responsibility of the Sponsor to use any financial information it obtains, including reports and audits, to monitor the fiscal condition and compliance of the School.

Disciplinary removals of students with disabilities are done so in accordance with IDEA and Section 504 requirements and at a similar rate to non-disabled students. Removals are documented in the Incident Management in PowerSchool. The school has evidence of implementation of the school's policies and procedures that describe the method for tracking removals for disciplinary reasons as well as systems for IEP and 504 teams to meet to review plans and develop interventions.

Details: Here's what you need to know about the Teaching Fellows Program: Provides fellowships for up to 215 students each year; Includes enrichment programs, professional development, and leadership opportunities; Supplies up to a \$6000 fellowship annually for four years; Requires participants to agree to teach in a SC public school one year for each year funding is received. Teaching Fellows must attend one of the eleven Teaching Fellows Institutions. These include Anderson University, Charleston Southern University, Clemson University, Coastal Carolina University, College of Charleston, Francis Marion University, Lander University, USC Aiken, USC Columbia, USC Upstate, and Winthrop University.

To apply for Teaching Fellows, a student must be: •A United States citizen or will be an eligible non-citizen under State Residency statutes at the time of high school graduation (Please note - students categorized as Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) are not eligible for Teaching Fellows.); •A legal resident of South Carolina (Please note - The Teaching Fellows Institution will verify residency after a student has been offered an award.); •A high school senior or a junior who is graduating early.
